RULES OF CONDUCT

BY VIRTUE OF REGISTRATION AND PARTICIPATION IN THIS EVENT, EACH PARTICIPANT AGREES TO ABIDE BY THESE RULES OF CONDUCT.

GENERAL EVENT RULES

REGISTRATION

1. Every participant must be registered for the event. Registered participants must wear an event bracelet to access all event programs, activities, and amenities.

FOOD

2. Only a registered participant is entitled to special event pricing when purchasing food from event food vendors, at their own expense.

TRANSACTIONS

3. Except for food vendor purchases, all onsite transactions during the event will be cashless, and conducted via credit card/online/app (e.g., Venmo).

CLEANLINESS

4. Participants must not litter and must place all trash in appropriate trash receptacles.
5. Participants with pets must pick up after their pets and discard pet poop in appropriate trash receptacles.

RULES RE: PETS

THESE RULES ARE TO ENSURE YOUR HEALTH AND SAFETY AS WELL AS THAT OF YOUR PET, AND THE HEALTH AND SAFETY OF OTHER PETS AND PARTICIPANTS

PLEASE NOTE THAT ALL PROGRAMING, ACTIVITIES AND SERVICES AT THIS EVENT ARE GEARED SOLELY TOWARD DOGS AND CATS

HEALTH

6. Participants must not bring any pet to the event that is exhibiting signs of illness, including but not limited to, coughing, sneezing, lethargy, vomiting, or diarrhea.

LEASH

7. All dogs must be on leash at all times during the event, except when in the dog run.
8. All cats must be on leash or in an appropriate carrier at all times during the event.
9. Pet leash, collar, and/or harness must be securely and appropriately fitted to the pet.

BEHAVIOR

10. Participants must supervise their pets at all times during the event. NO PET SHALL REMAIN UNATTENDED FOR ANY PERIOD OF TIME.
11. Participants are solely responsible for the total care of their pets at all times. This includes, but is not limited to, feeding, hydration, and potty breaks, as well as monitoring what and how much their pets ingest.
12. Participants will refrain from petting or engaging with another participant's pet without first seeking permission from that pet parent.

13. If a pet exhibits any aggressive or inappropriate behavior, the pet parent/participant will immediately remove the pet to a secure area, and also request the assistance of an onsite pet professional.

14. If the pet's behavior cannot be rectified and is deemed by F4P to be dangerous to the pet's safety or the safety of anyone else at the event, including but not limited to, other pets, the participant will be directed to remove the pet from the event.
